PhD position in Cellular Immunology

at the Department of Immune- and Tumor Biology starting latest in February 2025. The position is placed in the laboratory of Prof. Eva Kiermaier at the LIMES Institute in Bonn. The Institute is part of the Faculty of Mathematical and Natural Sciences at the University of Bonn.

We are seeking for a highly motivated PhD candidate to work at the interface of cell biology and immunology. The project focuses on the regulation of centrosomes during immune processes. We mainly concentrate on centrosome structure, function and regulation in human and mouse dendritic cells – the most potent antigen presenting cells of the innate immune system.

The lab combines cell based in vitro assays with studies in living animals (mouse) to provide a complete picture of the molecular basis of centrosome-mediated immunity.

The applicant should hold a master degree in cell biology, biochemistry or immunology. We particularly look for applicants with a collaborative attitude towards research and who can combine high personal ambition and work ethics with eagerness to contribute to other projects.

Salary is paid according to German TV-L (E13; 65%).
